Greetings in the Lord dear friends! As many of you probably saw on my personal news feed yesterday, our daughter had the great privilege to be on a 10 minute segment of yesterday's Bulgarian news. I want to take a minute to share with you why this has so touched our hearts. We started our journey to missions over 3 years ago now and have been serving in Bulgaria for just over 2 years. Our goal when we came here was to spread the gospel through a business as missions model. We wanted to integrate ourselves into the culture, with the people, meeting them where they are in their daily lives and evangelizing to them. Last year was a very tough year for us personally and in ministry.

But seeing our dear daughter in this clip is a reminder of what God can do when we least expect it. This video is all about Bulgarian culture. It's about how these children are being taught traditional Bulgarian folk dance, traditional songs, and being taught not to forget their Bulgarian culture. And here is our little American girl! Fully immersive with the people, where they are, showing them how she loves them and how she loves Jesus. It's a reminder that even the smallest of these have the opportunity to be an example for Christ. People are always curious why we, as Americans, have left what they see as the promised land, to be here. And even more curious when they see our children embracing their culture. I can't tell you how many doors this has opened to gospel conversations and relationships with unbelievers! After a year of what felt like no hope, we see God moving. Not only have we had opportunities through our children but the men's Bible study has now doubled in size! I am humbly reminded that His ways are not our ways, that with God all things are possible and that sometimes it's the things that you never expected that can have the biggest impact for Jesus! - Ryan and Stacy Fischer
