Prayer in the Life of a Believer - Tim Taylor

Without question there are areas as believers that we can continue to grow in and maybe one of the greatest is prayer. The Word of God is filled with prayer after prayer. Hannah prayed for her son Samuel, Solomon's prayer for wisdom, David's prayers in the book of Psalms and then the greatest example of prayer was Christ in John 17. 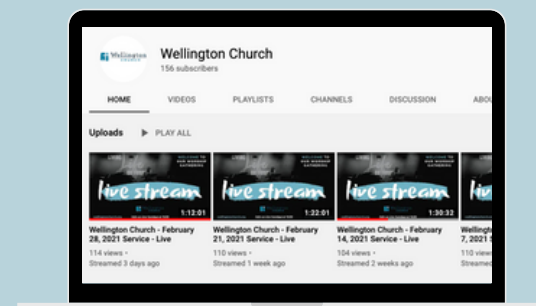
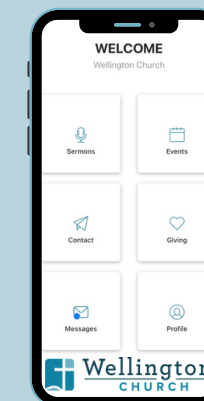


