Often when we are anxious and worry about things it is because we do not trust Him. 1 Peter 5:7: "cast all your anxiety on Him (Christ), for he cares for you." Psalm 56:8: "You have kept count of my tossing's, put my tears in your bottle. Are they not in your book?" I want to give you 7 helpful encouragements to trust God. Also, I would highly recommend you find a person in the church, order "Trusting God," and read through it together.

• When you are not trusting God, seek out Scripture: We are prone to the right now and fix now mindset. Turn to familiar passages in Scripture about trusting God and meditate or memorize them.

- Confess your lack of trust: Our world treats being anxious and worrying as normal, but as believers we are commanded not to worry and to trust God, so when we are not trusting God, we need to confess it because it is sin.
- Share with others your lack of trust: As a church we are a community of believers that looks to build up, encourage, admonish, and teach one another in order that we may be mature in Christ. The lack of trusting God is a part of the sanctification process, and that process was never intended to be in isolation. Find someone who will direct you back to God's Word and speak truth in your life.
- Spend time with God: Often when we do not trust God we are lacking in our reading and prayer life. When we do not trust God, we ramp up our time with God and maybe at times give up things to spend extra time in God's Word and in prayer.
- Look for things to be Thankful: Go through your life and see all the wonderful blessings that God has already provided. This can spur you on to know that if God provided then, he would provide now.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to help you. God has given to all believers a Helper that will always point us back to Christ and His Word. When our focus is not on Christ then we are living for the flesh not the Spirit.
- Wait: Be patient and see what the Lord is going to do in the situation and through you, because He does many wondrous things and we do not want to miss them. We live in a right now culture. Wait, trust God and when it gets hard because it will and can, find joy in Christ and His Word, not earthy things.

I hope this was helpful to you and encourages you to Trust God even when life is difficult.
